883 Residual Pressurized Spray  
EPA Registration No. 10900-70  
Your Submission Dated March 30, 1990

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- 1. Under the Precautionary Statements, delete the paragraph "Do not use in commercial food processing . . ." and replace it with:

Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. In the home, cover all food handling surfaces and cover or remove all food and cooking utensils, or wash thoroughly after treatment. Nonfood areas are areas such garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

- 2. Use in food handling establishments can imply use in U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Meat and Poultry Plants. Therefore, either add the statement "Not for Use in USDA Meat and Poultry Plants," or submit an application to USDA requesting use in these areas. If granted, you can then indicate on the label that the product can be used in these areas.

3. On the front panel in the uses sites, place "kennels" at the end so that "Nonfood areas of kennels" is not read. Also delete the colon after "commercial building."

4. Under Precautionary Statements add:

Do not apply to classrooms when in use.

5. Under: Statement of Practical Treatment revise "If swallowed . ." as follows:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration hazard.

6. Revise Disposal statement as follows:

Do not reuse container. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

The revised Confidential Statement of Formula dated March 3, 1990 is acceptable. However, please provide the flame extension (item no. 9) of the product including flashbacks if noted. If the flash point is zero please so state.

Submit five copies of your fina. printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

### 883 Residual Pressurized Spray

**Directions For Use:** It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**For Spot Treatment:**

**To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Spiders, Sawbugs and Carpet Beetles:** Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls, along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, apply to ant trails also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

**To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas:** Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do Not Spray Pets With This Product.

**For Crack and Crevices:**

**To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Sawbugs, Spiders, Brown Dog Ticks, Fleas, and Carpet Beetles:** Apply diluted spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Equipment capable of delivering a pin stream should be used in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where the above listed insects hide.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

**Fleas and Mosquitoes:** Use only out of doors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas

(such as under eaves) or porches, patios and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surface will be killed. Repeat treatment when necessary.

**Precautionary Statements:  
Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals**

**CAUTION**

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately wash eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Call a physician immediately.

Do not use in commercial food processing preparation, food storage or serving areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried.

If in eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
