To control fleas and brown dog ticks, thoroughly spray infested areas, including quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, baseboards, mouldings, window and door frames. Localized areas of floor and floor bedding should be placed in animal quarters for treatment. Concurrent treatment of premises is recommended. Repeat treatment as needed.
