## USE DIRECTIONS

Apply Arizona's Best Brand Cricket and Crawling Insect Killer granular insecticide uniformly to home lawns and other ornamental and recreational turf grass areas using any hand or power operated gravity or rotary type spreader designed for application of granular materials. Treat when insects first appear using Arizona's Best Brand Cricket and Crawling Insect Killer granules at the rate of 2½ pounds per 1,000 square feet. To help obtain uniform distribution, apply one-half the required amount of product in one direction; then apply the other one-half at a right angle. Immediately after application, sprinkle the turf with 30 gallons of water so as to wash the granules into the zone of insect infestation. Repeat as necessary.

## BAND TREATMENT AROUND HOUSE FOUNDATIONS

The following pests are commonly found around or near foundations of houses, as well as in lawns and gardens. Certain of these pests may enter houses:

Ants

Brown Dog Ticks

Earwigs

Sowbugs

Crickets

**HOW TO APPLY:** Apply a 5 foot band of Arizona's Best Brand Cricket and Crawling Insect Killer granules to the house foundation. Distribute granules uniformly using the rate of 2½ pounds for each 500 square foot area (5' x 100') treated.

**WHEN TO APPLY:** Apply when insects are present, especially in late spring or early fall. Repeat when necessary.

Do not reuse bag. Discard bag in trash.
