GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR GENERAL DISINFECTING of hard, non porous inanimate surfaces (glass, metal, plastic, glazed porcelain, linoleum, tile, leather, vinyl, enamel and finished wood surfaces) on walls, floors, appliances and furnishings in industrial and commercial offices, restrooms, and work areas. This product must not be used on contact surfaces.

CLEANING AND DEODORING. Whenever practical, flush away gross soils with water. For cleaning and deodorizing, use 5 to 8 ounces of PHENOMINT 7 per gallon of water.
