

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

MUNICIPAL REDUCTION OF MOSQUITO AND HOUSEFLY POPULATIONS. Mix 1 gallon of concentrate with 5 gallons of suitable solvent such as kerosene or diesel fuel. With this mixture, treat breeding areas such as city dumps, garbage heaps, sewage disposal areas, and alleys. Thoroughly wet all surfaces. Repeat when necessary.

FOR COCKROACHES: Mix 1 gallon of concentrate with 4 gallons diesel fuel or kerosene. Apply as a coarse, wet spray to garbage dumps, manholes, building foundations and garbage storage racks.

CAUTION

Do not reuse empty drum. Return to drum reconditioner or destroy by perforating or crushing and burying in a safe place away from water supplies.

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds.

Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur.

Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated.

FOR FOGGING AND MIST MACHINES:

Use 1 gallon of concentrate to 5 gallons of diesel fuel or kerosene. As a contact spray, fix the machine to produce a dry fog. For residual effect, fix the machine to produce a wet spray and wet the areas where insect control is desired. Do not apply or allow to drift to areas occupied by humans or animals.

NOTE: The carrier oil can burn vegetation. For these areas, Octicide 1 should be used.

For these areas Octicide 18 should be used.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly. Avoid contamination of food or feed. If swallowed get quick medical attention. Atropine is antidotal.
