SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. KEEP CONTAINER UPRIGHT.

This product will kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Fleas, Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Rice Weevils, Saw-Toothed Grain Beetles, Small Flying Moths, Ticks, Waterbugs, Palmetto Beetles, Grasshoppers, Carpet Beetles, Boxelder Bugs, Flat Grain Beetles, Caddisflies, Flour Beetles, Cigarette Beetles, Drugstore Beetles, Lesser Grain Borers, Merchant Grain Beetles, Grain Weevils, Red Flour Beetles, Sowbugs, Millipedes, Centipedes, Pillbugs, Silverfish, Firebrats, Bedbugs, Flies, Gnats, Booklice, Hornets, Wasps, Yellowjackets, Warehouse Beetles, Confused Flour Beetles, Deer Ticks, Ticks that may carry and transmit Lyme Disease, Fruit Flies, Foraging Ants, Harvester Ants, Flying Moths, Indian Meal Moths, Indian Mealworm, Angoumois Grain Moths and Yellow Mealworm. It will also prevent preadult fleas from developing into the adult biting stage up to 7 months (210 days).

Cover exposed food, dishes and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

TO OPERATE VALVE: To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press the valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in the center of the room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under fogger. Leave building at once and keep building closed for two hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

To Control Ticks and Fleas: Old bedding should be removed and replaced with fresh, clean bedding after treatment. Pets should be treated with a registered product for flea and tick control in conjunction with this treatment.

Do not use this unit in a cabinet or under a counter or table. Do not use the unit in an area less than 100 cubic feet.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: This container may be recycled in aerosol recycling centers. At present, there are only a few such centers in the country. Before offering for recycling, empty the can by using the product according to the label (DO NOT PUNCTURE!). If recycling is not available, wrap the container and discard in the trash.
