It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Algy Sol two way action kills established problem algae and remains active in water, working continuously to prevent further algae growth. It is non-foaming and compatible with any chemicals normally used to treat pool water. However, do not mix with dry or liquid chlorinating products in the same container. For best results, pools or spas containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using.

For Pools Free Of Algae

Initial Treatment: 8 to 12 oz. per 10,000 gallons of water  
Weekly Maintenance: 2 to 4 oz. per 10,000 gallons of water

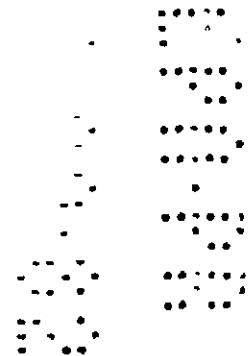
For Pools With Visible Established Algae

Add 16 oz. per 10,000 gallons of water. Wait 48 hours. Brush spots. Remove dead settled algae by vacuuming. Repeat dosage if necessary. When pool is clear follow normal maintenance schedule.

GENERAL CHEMISTRY REQUIREMENTS

(B) Information on the Specific Pesticide Formulation

1. Complete Composition

AQUAMAID ALGY SOL is composed of the following:

Active Ingredient..... 50.0 Percent  
Poly[oxyethylene(dimethyliminio)ethylene-(dimethyliminio)ethylene dichloride]

Inert Ingredient..... 50.0 Percent  
Water

2. AQUAMAID ALGY SOL is manufactured by combining 1 part by weight of WSCP (a 60 percent aqueous solution of Poly[oxyethylene(dimethyliminio)ethylene(dimethyliminio)ethylene dichloride], manufactured by Buckman Laboratories, Inc. with 0.2 parts by weight of water.

3. It is recommended that the containers in which AQUAMAID ALGY SOL is packaged be kept closed until product is used. For these conditions, the shelf life of the product has been established to be greater than one year. See attached Storage Stability data.

4. AQUAMAID ALGY SOL is manufactured by the simple addition of water to Buckman Laboratories, Inc. WSCP. To insure that the proper concentration of the active ingredient is obtained, a determination of the specific gravity of the diluted product is made. (See attached graph plotting specific gravity against active ingredients.)

However, to insure that the concentration is correct, the more precise determination of chloride concentration is periodically employed. This method is described on an attachment.

5. Duplicate samples of Lot 1 of AQUAMAID ALGY SOL were checked according to the methods described in (4) and the following results obtained:

Specific Gravity: Sample A - 1.122

Sample B - 1.124

6. Method of Disposal: Spills of AQUAMAID ALGY SOL should be absorbed in sawdust or sand and buried in an approved location. The empty container should be returned or destroyed by perforating or crushing and burying in an approved location.
