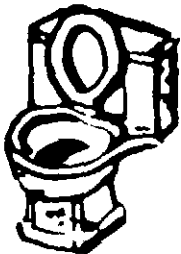

DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner not intended. For use in Factories, Office Buildings, Schools, Hotels, Restaurants, etc.
TOILET BOWLS: Remove water from bowl by forcing water out. Then pour a minimum of two ounces of cleaner on mop. Swab entire bowl under rim of water outlets. Flush toilet. Rinse mop.
ALTERNATE DIRECTION: Remove water from bowl by forcing water out of dispenser upside-down with opening in flow-control cap-pouring 2 inches from surface. Apply slight pressure on dispenser, forcing stream to come in contact with surface under rim. Allow to wet sides. Allow 2 ounces minimum to enter bowl. Allow to sit. Then swab area of bowl with mop. Swab seat and cover. After cleaning, flush toilet.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

DANGER: Corrosive. Causes eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes. Wear goggles and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal vapors or fumes. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after use.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Drink promptly a large quantity of water or milk. Do not induce vomiting. Get medical attention.
If In Eyes: Flush with plenty of water for 15 minutes.
If On Skin: Wipe off the acid gently, immediately flood with water. Wash freely, then cover with moist magnesium sulfate. If irritation persists, get medical attention.
