Almonds, apples, bananas, beans (dry), broccoli, brussels sprouts, cabbage, cauliflower, corn (sweet and popcorn), cranberries, cucumber, eggplant, endive, grapes, grasses, Kadota figs, kale, kohlrabi, lettuce (head and leaf), melons (to include: cantaloupe, casaba, crenshaw, honeydew, and watermelon), onions, ornamentals, papayas, peppers, potatoes, pumpkins, squash, sugar beets and uses for which USEPA has accepted the required data and/or citation of data that the formulator has submitted in support of reregistration and uses for experimental purposes that are in compliance with USEPA requirements.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
