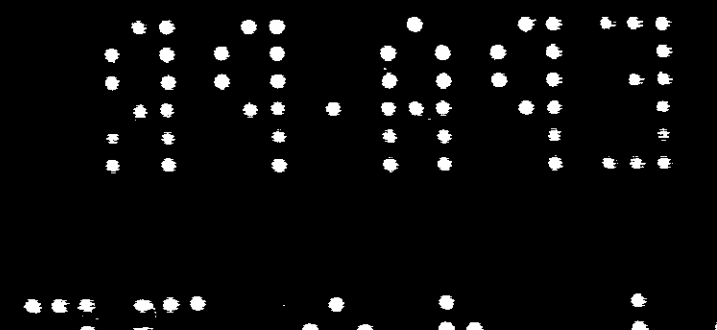

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply 15 grams of 'Primicid' 10 to each plant. Distribute the granules evenly over an area approximately 50 cm radius, around and up to the base of the plant, preferably after irrigation. The ground should be cleared of weeds before application. Repeat treatment at six-month intervals as needed if trap catches indicate population build-up to a damaging level.

CAUTION

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. May be harmful if swallowed.

Prolonged or repeated contact with skin may be harmful. Wear cotton gloves. Wash hands after use and avoid contamination of food or feedstuffs.

FIRST AID

If swallowed, induce vomiting. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. If inhaled, remove to fresh air. If breathing is difficult give oxygen. Call a physician. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

'Primicid' contains as the active ingredient an organophosphorus compound which inhibits cholinesterase. Atropine plus pralidoxime (P2S or P2AM) is an effective antidote.

CAUTION

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Keep out of any body of water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposing of wastes. Do not reuse container. Destroy when empty. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

Store in original container, tightly closed in a safe place.
