DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent) and dispose in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers, or bury in a safe place. Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable Federal, state or local procedures.

CROP: For control of damping-off, sore-shin and soil-borne diseases attacking cotton seedlings:

- (1) Apply Hexalint at rates of 3 oz. to 6 oz. in 5-15 gallons of water per acre in seed furrow when cotton is planted deep (1 inch to 2 1/2 inches).
- (2) Apply Hexalint at rates of 3 oz. to 6 oz. in a 10-15 inch band over seeded row in 10-15 gallons of water per acre where cotton is shallow planted. May be applied at these rates with banded herbicides used at planting time.

(3) Make additional applications in all areas if conditions warrant as plants emerge or after emergence at intervals of 5-7 days and at rates of 2 oz. to 6 oz. per acre in 2-10 gallons water per acre.

Use lower rate for banded sprays and heavier rates for broadcast applications. May be applied with early season insecticides or with post emergence herbicides.

Hexalint is designed for use with and should be compatible with most herbicides and insecticides commonly used on cotton. However, all formulations should be checked for physical compatibility before use.

For control of boll-rotting of cotton:


Begin control program by applying Hexalint in last herbicide application (lay by) at rate of 8 oz. per acre to reduce inoculum potential.

Continue treatment program when first bolls are formed by spraying Hexalint at 4 oz. per acre by air or ground. Continue 5-7 day intervals or oftener (3 to 4 days) if severe conditions warrant. For best results apply in aerial or ground ULV sprays. Do not use within seven days of harvest.
