It also provides postemergence control of crabgrass when applied 2 to 4 weeks after crabgrass germination. Post-emergence control is limited to crabgrass only. Application of this product later than 4 weeks after crabgrass germination will result in reduced control of crabgrass. For control of the weed grasses and broadleaf weeds listed on this label (other than crabgrass), it must be applied as a preventative treatment before the weed seeds germinate.
