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**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**SANTIZING GLASSES AND DISHES:**

After washing with a good detergent immerse for at least one half (1/2) minute in a solution of one (1) level tablespoon SANTIZER/GERMICIDE to five (5) gallons of water. This gives 100 ppm available chlorine. Use test paper at frequent intervals to determine if chlorine is up to required strength. Chlorine level must be kept at a minimum of 100 ppm. Rinse and allow to drain thoroughly.

**DEODORIZING AND DISINFECTING:**

For walls and floors, refrigerators, refuse cans, bathroom fixtures and tubs, etc., use one (1) level tablespoon per gallon of water (50 ppm available chlorine) and spray or flush with solution. Let stand for 24 minutes. Rinse well with potable water and dry.

**DAIRY AND FOOD PROCESSING  
EQUIPMENT:**

Wash with good detergent, rinse and sanitize with a solution of one (1) level tablespoon of SANTIZER/GERMICIDE to each five (5) gallons of water or one (1) cup to eighty (80) gallons (100 ppm available chlorine). Flow the solution through the equipment for a minimum of two (2) minutes. Test solution frequently making sure that available chlorine level never falls below fifty (50) ppm. Rinse and allow to drain thoroughly.

**SOLUTION TABLE**

Available Chlorine	Gallons of water per level tablespoon	Gallons of water per standard cup
100 ppm	5	80
200 ppm	2 1/2	40
400 ppm	1 1/4	20

Note: 1 standard tablespoon of SANTIZER/GERMICIDE weighs 18.5 grams (0.66 oz.).

Three level teaspoons equal one level tablespoon.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition isolate container, if possible, and flood with large amounts of water to dissolve all material before discarding. Place in trash collection or dispose in approved landfill area, or bury in a safe place.

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
