DANGER

DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its label.

Open recirculating water tower and evaporative condenser systems. To control bacterial and fungal slime.

1. Begin treatment when the system is in jeopardy of becoming affected or after cleaning systems whose efficiency is already impaired.
2. Initial dose - 26.52 fl. oz. OLIN 3210 per 1,000 gal. water (200-400 ppm) applied directly to the cooling tower basin near the inlet to the recirculating pump. Repeat until control is achieved.
3. Subsequent dose - 6.5195 fl. oz. OLIN 3210 per 1,000 gal. water (150-150 ppm) applied every 7 days or as needed to maintain control.
