Submission of updated label dated May 12, 1994

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the changes listed below.

1. The precautionary statements must appear under the heading "Precautionary Statements" and the subheading "Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals." Amend the precautionary statements to read as follows:

Precautionary Statements
Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals
Caution

Do not get on skin, eyes or clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mist. Concentrate may cause skin damage. Use waterproof gloves when handling concentrate. In case of contact, immediately remove contaminated clothing and flush skin or eyes with plenty of water; for eyes, get medical attention. Avoid wetting the hides of animals.

2. A statement of practical treatment is required for your product. Add the following statement of practical treatment to your label:

Statement of Practical Treatment

IF SWALLOWED: Call a doctor or get medical attention. Do not induce

vomiting. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Avoid alcohol.

IF ON SKIN: Immediately wash skin with plenty of soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

- The environmental hazards statement must be located under the heading "Precautionary Statements" and under the subheading "Environmental Hazards." Amend the environmental hazards statement as follows:

Environmental Hazards

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of equipment washwaters.

This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds while bees are actively visiting the treatment area.

- Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

This product is suitable for use in Filt Guns, Microsol Foggers, Heat Generating Foggers, Dairy Barn Foggers, Hydro-Guns or suitable automatic atomizing application equipment.

USE UNDILUTED: Apply as a finely atomized space spray using applicator adjusted to produce particle sizes not smaller than 30 microns.

GENERAL USE: In and Around House: Open Air Theaters, Restaurants, Drive-Ins, also in and around Dairy Barns, Livestock Barns, Pig Pens, Poultry Houses, Feed Lots, Cattle Pens, Horse Stables, Garbage Dumps, Outside Meat Packing Establishments (including Federally Inspected) for control of Resistant and Non-Resistant Houseflies, Lesser Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Gnats: Direct spray throughout the fly infested areas, spraying around and above animals but not directly at animals. Repeat as necessary. Do not use in milk processing rooms. Do not use fog applications in dwellings and restaurants.

DAIRY BARN FOGGERS: Resistant and Non-Resistant Houseflies, Lesser Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Gnats: Use approximately 1 ounce in 3000 cubic feet of space. Close all doors and windows where possible before fogging. Cows may be in barn during fogging operations. Apply around and above animals but not directly at animals.

POULTRY PROCESSING AND PACKING PLANTS: Around Outside and In-Edible Product Areas Inside Buildings: Direct spray throughout the fly infested areas. Repeat as necessary. Exposed food products and packaging materials must be removed from the room or protected. After using this material, equipment and utensils must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water before operations are resumed.

WINERIES, CANNERIES, CIDER MILLS, FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS, LOADING DOCKS, CULL PILES, REFUSE AREAS: Drosophila (Fruit Fly) - Spray as necessary contacting walls, floors, doorways, windows, refuse piles and cull piles except those for stock feed. Avoid contamination of feeds, foodstuffs and food processing machinery. Do not apply in the edible product areas of food processing plants.

ROACHES (Water Bugs) - Spot Application Only: For Control of All Species of Resistant and Non-Resistant Cockroaches, including German, Brown-Banded, Oriental and American Roaches in and around Dwellings, Dairies, Barns and Other Buildings where Roaches Exist - Apply as a coarse spray to areas infested by roaches to contact insects as much as possible. Treat as necessary applying to cracks, crevices, hiding places and adjacent exposed surfaces where insects may be contacted. Do not apply in the edible product areas of food processing plants.
