
The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

1. Delete "and their eggs" from the front panel, since there is no adequate data supporting this claim.

Please note that the last accepted Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated July 17, 1987 identifies petroleum distillate as an active ingredient. Please provide an updated CSF to reflect the purpose of this component in the formulation.

Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Apply undiluted to hair and scalp or any other infested areas until entirely wet. Do not use on eyelashes or eyebrows. Allow treatment to remain 10 minutes, but no longer. Then wash thoroughly with warm water and shampoo or soap. Dead lice and eggs may require removal with enclosed fine-toothed comb. Repeat treatment in 7 - 10 days or earlier if reinfestation has occurred. Do not exceed two applications within 24 hours. To help eliminate infestations, it is important to sterilize all clothing and bedding of infested person at time of treatment.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store product in original container above freezing and away from children. Do not reuse container; wrap in several layers of newspaper before discarding in trash.
