The application referred to above, submitted under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended is acceptable under FIFRA sec 3(c)(5). You must submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration/registration review of your product when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. You must submit one (1) copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.



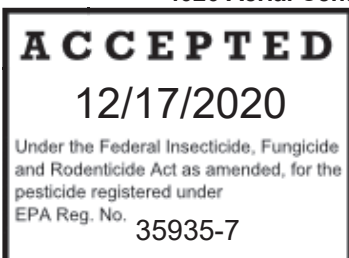
NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

- 1) **AGRICULTURAL CROPS:** Corn (Field, Pop and Sweet), Cereal Grains (Barley, Intermediate Wheatgrass, Millet, Oats, Rye and Wheat), Rice, Sorghum (Grain and Forage), Soybeans (preplant), Sugarcane, Grasses Grown for Seed or Sod, Rangeland, Fallow Cropland, Crop Stubble, Pasture, Annual Grasses, Perennial Grasses, Asparagus, Blueberries, Cranberries, Grapes (only in California, Oregon and Washington), Hops, Orchard Floors (Pome Fruits, Stone Fruit, Nut Orchards, Filberts, Pistachios), Potatoes (fresh market only), and Strawberries.

TERRESTRIAL NONFOOD CROPS: Ornamental trees, shrubs and vines; Ornamental Turf (including golf courses, cemeteries, parks, sports fields, turfgrass, lawns and other grass areas); Uncultivated agricultural areas; Uncultivated nonagricultural areas (including fencerows, hedgerows, roadsides, ditches, rights-of-way, utility power lines, railroads, airports, and industrial sites; General soil treatment; Recreation areas; Industrial sites; Paved areas and Outdoor areas.
