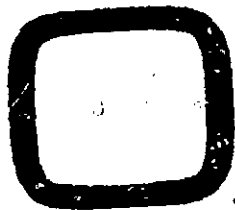

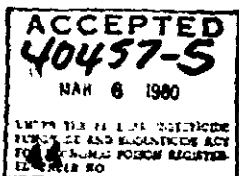
FIRST AID:

O-C SENTINEL WASH AND SURFACE SANITIZER is recommended for use on hard non-porous surfaces, dishes, glasses, food processing equipment including dairy and brewery equipment or similar equipment. It is a strong sanitizer and works with little or no cleaning material. It is also very effective on table tops, vats, tanks, floors, etc.

Dissolve 1 lb. of O-C SENTINEL WASH AND SURFACE SANITIZER in 10 gal. of water to give a solution concentration of 200 ppm available chlorine. After rinsing and rinsing gross dirt and heavy soil deposits, surface, apply the sanitizing solution to the surface to be sanitized. Stand 2 to 5 minutes. Rinse well with potable water and dry. The surface is ready for use.

The same solution may be used in the feed tanks of swine and other animals allowing 2 to 5 minutes contact time for sanitizing. Clean and disinfect food processing equipment and grounds. Clean and disinfect farm buildings. After sanitizing, rinse well with potable water and dry. The surface is ready for use.

The sanitizing solution should be used promptly after mixing. If the solution is allowed to stand or is recirculated, the level of available chlorine will be maintained, additional O-C SENTINEL WASH AND SURFACE SANITIZER should be added to maintain a 200 ppm solution concentration of available chlorine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Store in a cool, dry area away from direct sunlight or heat. Do not flood areas with large quantities of water. Store empty containers in a clean, dry area and do not place in trash collection or recycling approved landfill area. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage or cleaning of equipment.

O-C SENTINEL WASH AND SURFACE SANITIZER is recommended for use on hard non-porous surfaces: dishes, glassware, food processing equipment including dairy and brewery equipment in contact with food that need a strong sanitizer treatment with little or no rinsing action. This material is also very effective on table tops, vats, tanks, floors and walls.

Dissolve 1 1/2 oz. O-C SENTINEL WASH AND SURFACE SANITIZER per 10 gal. of water to give a solution concentration of 200ppm available chlorine. After rinsing and rinsing gross dirt and heavy soil deposits from the surface, apply the sanitizing solution to the surface to be sanitized and let stand 2 to 5 minutes. Rinse well with potable water and dry. The surface is then ready for use.

The same solution may be used in the free tanks of immersion or spray type machines allowing 2 to 5 minute contact time for sanitizing dishes, glassware, food processing equipment and utensils. Clean and rinse items prior to sanitizing. After sanitizing rinse well with potable water and dry. The items are then ready for use.

The sanitizing solution should be used promptly after mixing. If the solution is allowed to stand or is frozen and tests show the level of chlorine has not been maintained, additional O-C SENTINEL WASH AND SURFACE SANITIZER should be added to maintain a one million concentration of 200ppm available chlorine.

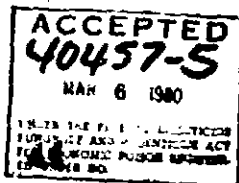
STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
