

O-C SENTINEL WASH AND SURFACE SANITIZER is recommended for use on hard non porous surfaces, dishes, glasses, food processing equipment including dairy and brewery equipment or metal surfaces. It is also very effective on table tops, vinyl, tanks, drums and containers.

Dilute 1 part O-C SENTINEL WASH AND SURFACE SANITIZER to 10 gal of water to give a solution concentration of 5.5% available chlorine. After cleaning and rinsing remove glass, tubs and heavy soil deposits from surface. Apply the sanitizing solution to the surface to be sanitized 2 to 3 minutes. Rinse well with potable water and dry. The surface is now ready for use.

The same solution may be used in the food tanks of enterprises or in surfaces allowing 2 to 3 minute contact time for sanitizing dishes, food processing equipment and utensils. Clean and rinse thoroughly. After rinsing, rinse well with potable water and dry. The surface is now ready for use.

The sanitizing solution should be used promptly after mixing. If it is allowed to stand or is reused and tests above the level of chlorine has been maintained, additional O-C SENTINEL WASH AND SURFACE SANITIZER should be added to maintain a 5% chlorine concentration. Available chlorine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Store in a cool, dry area away from direct sunlight or heat. Do not store near large quantities of water. These empty containers must be rinsed with water and dried by placing in trash collection or by approved methods. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage or cleaning of equipment.



O-C SENTINEL WASH AND SURFACE SANITIZER is recommended for use on hard non-porous surfaces: dishes, glasses, food processing equipment including dairy and brewery equipment, or metal vessels that need a strong sanitizer treatment with little or no cleaning action. This material is also very effective on table tops, vinyl, tarp, floors and walls.

Dissolve 1% of O-C SENTINEL WASH AND SURFACE SANITIZER per 10 gal. of water to give a solution concentration of 200 ppm available chlorine. After rinsing and removing gross filth and heavy soil deposits from the surface, apply the sanitizing solution to the surface to be sanitized and let stand 2 to 5 minutes. Rinse well with potable water and dry. The surface is then ready for use.

The same solution may be used in the free state of immersion or spray type machines allowing 2 to 5 minute contact time for sanitizing dishes, glasses, food processing equipment and vessels. Clean and rinse items prior to sanitizing. After sanitizing rinse well with potable water and dry. The items are then ready for use.

The sanitizing solution should be used promptly after mixing. If the solution is allowed to stand or is reused and tests show the level of chlorine has not been maintained, additional O-C SENTINEL WASH AND SURFACE SANITIZER should be added to maintain a new minimum concentration of 200 ppm available chlorine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool, dry area away from direct sunlight or heat. In case of spill, flush area with large quantities of water. Empty container thoroughly with water and discard by placing in a solid waste bin or burying it in approved landfill area. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal, or cleaning of equipment.
