NOTIFICATION OF ADDITION OF OPTIONAL MARKETING STATEMENTS PER PR NOTICE 98-10

Alliance Trading, Inc., 109 Northpark Blvd., 4th Floor, Covington, LA 70433 is submitting this notification to add optional marketing statements to our Olympic Klear Out registration (EPA Reg. No. 42177-2). This notification includes addition of statements that can be added by Non-Notification.

Two optional marketing statements, "Kills Bacteria" and "Controls Algae" are added pursuant to Section II K.1. reflecting pesticide categorization of the approved product label's end uses and is related to the product's characterization as a "Shock Treatment".

An additional optional marketing statement being added is "1 Pound Treats Up To 15,000 Gallons". This is permitted under Section II M.2., Directions for Use. The statement contains the information that represents the same use directions already approved by EPA in narrative form and allows the consumer to quickly understand the dosing potential of the product per unit volume of pool water.

Two other optional statements, "Quick Dissolving" and "Restores Sparkle and Clarity to Pool" are added by Non-Notification pursuant to Section IV F.1. that allows these statements which make characteristic claims that are **not** related to pesticidal effectiveness

"This notice is consistent with the provisions of PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR §152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 98-10 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA."

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Klear Out is designed for the rapid control of algae and for superchlorination at time of pool opening. These quick dissolving granules will destroy most strains of unsightly algae within 24 hours. Dead algae will come to rest on the pool floor. Remove by vacuuming frequently.

POOL OPENING:

For new pool or spring start up, superchlorinate with 10 to 20 ounces for each 10,000 gallons of water to yield 5 to 10 ppm available chlorine by weight. Check the level of available chlorine with a test kit. Adjust and maintain pool water pH to between 7.2 to 7.6. Adjust and maintain the alkalinity between 50 to 100 ppm.

TREATMENT OF ALGAE GROWTH:

For Visible Algae Growth - Superchlorinate the pool with 10 to 20 ounces of product for each 10,000 gallons of water to yield 5 to 10 ppm available chlorine by weight. Check the level of available chlorine with a test kit.

NOTE: Re-entry into treated swimming pool is prohibited above levels of 3.0 ppm of chlorine.

Vinyl Pools – Pre dissolve product in a plastic bucket. Stir. Let insoluble matter settle to the bottom of the bucket. Pour liquid solution into deep end of pool. If algae persists, repeat treatment. To control algae growth – Superchlorinate every 7 days by adding 10 ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water.
