DOSE RECOMMENDATIONS:

For aqueous applications only; not compatible with waxes.

In dips, wash tanks, and drenchers: Dilute 64 – 96 fl. oz. of FUNGAFLO 100SL in 99.5 gallons water (500-750 ppm imazalil base) The treatment solutions should be inspected periodically to insure the proper concentration of active ingredient. Length of dip time should not exceed two minutes.

In non-recovery spray & water spray brush application : Dilute 1 gallon of FUNGAFLO 100SL in 99 gallons of water (1000 ppm imazalil base). Apply to freshly cleaned citrus prior to waxing.

Remark 1: Combinations of above-listed treatments are possible, but never more than two treatments should be carried out on the same citrus lot.
