- c. Change the word **"sprays"** to **"pumps"** in the directions for use, i.e., "Apply at the rate of 2 **pumps** (of spray) for every pound of body weight." Also give an example of how much spray is required to cover an average size dog or cat. We believe further clarification is necessary in this regard, since the target user group is the homeowner and we want to minimize the potential for misuse as much as possible.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product will kill fleas up to 14 days and ticks up to 4 days on dogs. This product will also kill fleas up to 14 days and ticks up to 9 days on cats.

**HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT.
SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING.**

Rubber gloves should be worn when applying this product. Spray the animal from a distance of 8-12 inches. Apply at the rate of 2 sprays for every pound of body weight. Do not spray on face, eyes or genitalia. Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure the animal's entire body is covered, including the legs and under the body. Fluff the hair as you spray so the spray will penetrate to the skin. Combing or brushing helps to disperse spray evenly. The spray should wet ticks thoroughly. Repeat as needed.
