This registration is being issued in accordance with Section 3(c)(1)(A) of the FIFRA subject to the following conditions.

(1) It is understood that you will submit and/or cite all data required for registration or re-registration of your product under Section 3(c)(5) of the FIFRA when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

(2) The registration number which has been assigned to this product must appear on the label as EPA Registration No. 43980-4.

(3) You will submit five copies of your finished printed label as described in the A-72 enclosure. These labels must be submitted to the Agency before your release the product for shipment to comply with PP Notice 82-2 of June 18, 1982. Refer to Section 162.10 of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations for general labeling requirements. Failure to comply with these requirements may result in rejection of your label.

I stamped one of the draft labels enclosed for your records. Your release of the product for shipment constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with Section 3(c) of the FIFRA.

Hand Sanitizing — In food handling and meat cutting operations: Rinse hands and immerse in a 1 oz. **NAR-I-DINE 1.75** per 5 gals. of water solution (25 ppm titratable iodine).

Retort Cooling Water — For canning operations — add 1 oz. **NAR-I-DINE 1.75** per 5-10 gallons of retort water prior to starting up operation to control slime and odor causing bacteria.

Poultry Drinking Water Sanitization — 1 oz. **NAR-I-DINE 1.75** per 10 gallons of drinking water.

Shoe Bath Sanitizer — To prevent tracking harmful organisms into animal areas, scrape shoes and place in a 3 oz. per gallon solution of **NAR-I-DINE 1.75** for 30 seconds prior to entering area.
