OUTDOOR SPRAY TO REDUCE THE ANNOYANCE OF FLIES, ADULT MOSQUITOES, GNATS & SMALL FLYING MOTHS around paties, swimming pools, home yards, & outdoor areas in parks & playgrounds: When the air is still, spray as a fine mist or fog to penetrate hiding places such as grasses, shrubs & ornamentals around homes, picnic areas, stadiums & open air theaters. Treat as large an area as possible surrounding the patio, pool or grounds where insect protection is desired. Repeated applications may be necessary when infestation is heavy. Apply at the rate of 1.5 gallons per acre (4.4 ft. oz. per 1,000 sq. ft.) Do not spray flowers & ornamentals at close range. Allow only the fine mist or "dry" fog to contact desirable plants. Direct spray away from the swimming pool. Application to any body of water is prohibited. INDOOR SPRAY FOR CONTROL OF FLIES, ADULT MOSQUITOES, GNATS & SMALL FLYING MOTHS in homes, food establishments, farm buildings & warehouses, Close all windows & stop all ventilators. Spray outside walls of grain bins, flooring, about the base of milling machinery, walls, baseboards, areas behind cabinets, around pipes, & inside surfac ... If boxcars & trucks using 1 gallon of spray per 1,000 sq. ft. of space, apply in small amounts directly into cracks & crevice using equipment capable of delivering a pin stream in points between equipment & floors, openings leading to voids & hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs & bases, conduits, motor housings & junction or switch boxes. Prior to application, de-energize equipment. After application, allow time for oil to evaporate before starting motors or placing switching in "on" position. Repeat applications as necessary. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area thoroughly before re- entry, infested stored food products should be furnigated or treated by other effective methods using an approved product intended for this purpose. CONTACT AND SPACE SPRAY.—TO KILL COCKROACHES, SILVERFISH, EARWIGS, ANTS, SPIDERS IN SHELTERED SITUATIONS: Adjust soraying device to deliver a coarse wat spray. Apply as a contact spry into all cracks and crevice in woodwork, walls, floors, underneath sinks, behind pipes & in all places where these insects shelter. Contact as many insects as possible. Do not allow spray to contact stored food. Then adjust sprayer to deliver aerosol stes particles. Apply as a space spray at a rate of 3 to 6 ft, oz. per 1,000 cu. ft. of room space. Repeat docage as necessary for control. Leave the room closed for 1 hour. Do not remain in treated area. Ventilitie the area thoroughly before re-entry. FOR WASPS AND SPIDERS: Spray insects directly & apply heavy apray to nest & webs. The most effective wasp control is obtained by spraying after dark when all reest have returned to the rest. FOR CONTROL OF CARPET BEETLES. Clean all rugs, carpets & fabrics to be treated. Spray both surfaces of carpets & floor space beneath everly with a fine mist spray. Particular attention should be paid to cracks & cravices around the baseboards. ANNAL SPRAY FOR HORSES & DARY & BEEF CATTLE: Fo. protection against stableties, horrifles & houseflise attacking arimsts, spray the arimal against the grain of the hair, directing a fine mist around the base of the horns, on the legs & along the sides & belly & over the back. Do not spray udders. Apply just enough to wat the ends of the hair but not enough to wat the hide. One or two ounces of spray is sufficient to treat an adult cow.
