WARNING

**POISONOUS BY SKIN CONTACT,

- Toxaphene is poisonous by skin contact, inhalation, or swallowing.
- It may be fatal if swallowed.
- Do not get on skin, in eyes, or on clothing.
- It can be absorbed through the skin.
- Do not breathe spray mist.
- Wash thoroughly after using.
- Wash all contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before reuse.
- During application, keep unprotected persons away from areas being treated or where there may be drift.
- Do not contaminate feed or foodstuffs.
- This product is toxic to bees and should not be applied when bees are actively visiting the area.

Protective clothing and respirators are required for all applicators and other personnel involved in mixing, loading, transferring or otherwise handling this pesticide. Protective clothes must consist of hats, impermeable gloves, rubber or synthetic rubber boots or foot covers, long-sleeved shirts and long pants. Full-face respirators are recommended; half-face respirators are required. In lieu of compliance with the protective measures required for applicators, users may use closed system methods of mixing, loading and handling. However, it is recommended that mixers and loaders wear water proof gloves. Aerial applicators in positive pressure cock-pits and other applicators in comparable ground equipment with appropriate filters at all air intakes need not comply with these protective clothing requirements.

FIRST-AID TREATMENT

INTERNAL: If toxaphene is swallowed, do not induce vomiting. See "Physician's Note." Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. CALL A PHYSICIAN IN ALL CASES OF SUSPECTED POISONING.

EXTERNAL: Remove contaminated clothing and wash skin thoroughly with soap and water. If in eyes, flush with clean water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician.

PHYSICIAN'S NOTE: If swallowed, use gastric lavage. Avoid aspiration. Toxaphene produces central nervous system excitation that responds to barbituric acid derivatives. Prevent or control convulsions with barbiturates, preferably administered intravenously. If the barbiturate can be given before convulsions start, sodium pentobarbital is the drug of choice. Since toxaphene has a fairly long duration of action, a long-acting barbiturate such as phenobarbital may be used after initial control of convulsions. Refer to "Clinical Handbook on Economic Poisons," which was prepared by the U.S. Department of Health, Education, and Welfare, Public Health Service, Communicable Disease Center, Atlanta, Georgia.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Use of this product may be fatal to birds and other wildlife in treated areas. Do not spray over lakes, streams, ponds, tidal marshes and estuaries. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from treated areas. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Over-spray of this product into water at application rates recommended on this label may be fatal to shrimp and crabs. Do not apply where these are important resources. Apply this product only as specified on this label.
