MACHINE LAUNDERING
For front-loading machines, use ½ cup per load. For top-loading and wringer-type machines, use 1 cup per load. For machines with automatic bleach dispensers, follow machine directions.

If bleach cannot be used on clothes are in the recommended amount of water; then add bleach to clothes are the machine has started.

DIRECTIONS FOR CLEANING AND DISINFECTATION

TO CLEAN AND DISINFECT

Enamel, porcelain, marble, woodwork, or dairy equipment should be thoroughly washed before use. Add 2 tablespoons of bleach to every quart of water. Rinse surface with clean water. Allow solution to stand for 10 minutes before rinsing. Rinse all treated surfaces with clean water. Do not reuse.

Do not use bleach on leather, mohair, or non-fast colors. Use upright and tight fitting cover in a cool place.

Do not use on silver, chipped enamel or linoleum. Do not use on natural sponge.

FOR DEODORIZATION OF TUBS, TOILETS AND

Clean and pour water down drain. Allow running water through drain.
