To control fleas, ticks and lice: Holding can upright, spray
the animal with short bursts from a distance of 10 to 12
inches. Starting at the tail, stroke against the lay of the
hair, spraying the parted fur directly behind the hand to
insure penetrating the coat. Dampen the fur up to the head.
Spraying a cat 20 to 30 seconds or an average dog 30 to 45
seconds is usually sufficient. Repeat application weekly if
necessary to control reinfestation.

Do not treat or cause exposure to kittens or puppies under
four weeks of age.

To control infestation in sleeping quarters, after treating
animals, spray bedding, walls and floor with special atten-
tion to cracks and crevices.
