DIRECTIONS FOR USE

PREPARATION OF BUILDING:

Remove birds, pets and fish bowls from area to be treated. Remove occupants from room while applying mist spray. Cover exposed fruits, vegetables, foods and food handling equipment to prevent contamination. Open cabinets and other enclosures to allow mist spray to penetrate all areas. Shut off all fans and air conditioners. Close all outside windows and doors. Extinguish all open flames, including pilot lights.

APPLICATION OF SPRAY:

With mist applicator, direct spray behind refrigerators, cabinets, and other fixtures where pests hide. Then place spray applicators to give complete dispersion of mist spray throughout the room. Apply spray at the rate of one gallon per 50,000 cubic feet of room volume. **APPLICATOR SHOULD WEAR A DUST MASK OR OTHER SUITABLE EQUIPMENT TO PREVENT INHALATION OF SPRAY PARTICLES.** Leave room undisturbed for at least 2 hours after application has been completed.

KILLS: Roaches, ants, flying moths, crickets, spiders, flies, silverfish, and certain other insects in supermarkets, restaurants, dwellings, apartment houses, office buildings, warehouses, etc.
