DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

BIOCIDE C-140 is used in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and whirlpool spas. Heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using. For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of BIOCIDE C-140 fluid ounces of BIOCIDE C-140 to move settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a pool add initially 10 to 18 fluid ounces of BIOCIDE C-140 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of BIOCIDE C-140 per 10,000 gallons should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains require an initial dose of 2 to 3 fluid ounces of BIOCIDE C-140 per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a fresh hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially 1 fluid ounce of BIOCIDE C-140 per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of BIOCIDE C-140 should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment. BIOCIDE C-140 is compatible with chlorine chemicals used to treat pools, spas, and decorative fountains. BIOCIDE C-140 is compatible with alkaline pH. BIOCIDE C-140 is compatible with decorative fountains treated with chlorine chemicals and other chemicals normally required. However, do not mix BIOCIDE C-140 with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Containers should be placed in a plastic bag and stored away from clear water. All pesticides should be kept away from food.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Dispose of contents and container as directed.
