#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For use in Homes, and Non-Food Areas of Kennels, Commercial Buildings, Warehouses, Theaters, Office Buildings, Schools, Motels, and Hotels.

**TO KILL FLEAS (ADULT, PRE-ADULT AND LARVAE) AND TICKS:** Spray should be applied uniformly, using a sweeping motion to carpets, rugs, draperies, upholstered furniture, etc. Spray until slightly wet, allow to dry one hour and vacuum dead insects. Repeat as necessary. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, windows, and door frames, wall cracks, and local areas of floors. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after spray has dried. **DO NOT "PRAY ANIMALS"** Animals should be treated with a registered product to kill fleas and ticks before entering area.

**TO KILL ROACHES, SILVERFISH, SPIEDERS, EARWIGS, CARPET BEETLES, SOWBUGS, WATERBUGS:** Spray on carpet and on floor along baseboards, directly into cracks, crevices, and all places suspected of harborage. Contact as many insects as possible with spray.

#### CAUTION: PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

##### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

May be fatal if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid dusting, spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. In case of contact immediately flush skin and eyes with plenty of water. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. If poisoning occurs, get prompt medical aid.

Do not use in food areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

##### NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:

Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine, by injection, is antidote of choice.

##### PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130 degrees F may cause bursting. Combustible

##### FIRST AID:

**IF SWALLOWED:** Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Call a physician.

**IF IN EYES:** Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

**IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Remove contaminated clothing. Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

**IF INHALED:** Remove to fresh air if side effects occur. Call a physician.

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
