

ALL PURPOSE ALGAECIDE is used in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and innum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using. For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial fluid ounces of ALL PURPOSE ALGAECIDE per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of ALL PURPOSE ALGAECIDE per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains require an initial dose of 17 to 26 fluid ounces per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially 9 fluid ounces of ALL PURPOSE ALGAECIDE per 1,000 gallons of water. ALL PURPOSE ALGAECIDE should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment. ALL PURPOSE ALGAECIDE is compatible with alkaline pH. ALL PURPOSE ALGAECIDE should be used to treat pools, spas, and decorative fountains with alkaline pH. ALL PURPOSE ALGAECIDE should be used on decorative fountains treated with chlorine chemicals and chemicals normally required. However, do not mix ALL PURPOSE ALGAECIDE with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.
