

**USE DIRECTIONS**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**FOR GENERAL DISINFECTION** of hard, non-porous inanimate surfaces (glass, metal, plastic, glazed porcelain, linoleum, tile, leather, vinyl, enamel and finished wood surfaces) on walls, floors, appliances and furnishings in industrial and commercial offices, restrooms and work areas.

**CLEANING AND DEODORIZING.** Whenever practical, flush away gross soils with water. For cleaning and deodorizing, use 2½ to 4 ounces of THIS PRODUCT per gallon of water. Cleaning may be accomplished with a clean mop, sponge, squeegee, wet vacuum system, or a mechanical spraying device. After cleaning remove suspended soils with a clear water rinse, vacuum pick up or by wiping with a clean mop, sponge, squeegee or cloth.
