FOR TERRESTRIAL USES: Do not apply directly to water, or areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the high water mark.

BioMagnetTM SWD is an attract-and-kill device with an integrated hook. The device contains powerful food attractants for the fruit flies and the external surface is coated with an insecticide. Adult fruit flies are attracted to the device, contact and acquire the insecticide and die (insect death is not immediate). For use on outdoor crops, ventilated greenhouses and shadehouses.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. For any requirements specific to your State or Tribe, consult the State or Tribal agency responsible for pesticide regulation.

AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS: Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR part 170. Place BioMagnet[™] SWD early in the season while fruit fly populations are still low at start of the first flight of flies and in any case before the fruits become susceptible to be attacked.

Place the devices in thick branches or field structures using the integrated hook. Make sure they are securely attached to the branch or structure. Do not deploy in wires.

Place them in the shadyest and freshest part of the canopy (north-facing part of the plant). Distribute devices through the field to achieve the desired dose, which will depend on damage history, neighboring plots and expected pest pressure for the year. Reinforce borders or other especially challenging areas. Do not damage the product during trimming, pruning or any other agronomic activities. Do not place the devices near or above developing fruits to prevent direct contact with the fruits.

Apply 1 to 2 per year in listed crops that are cultivated throughout many months with successive harvests In these crops, the 2nd application can help protect during the whole growing season. In the rest of the listed crops, a single application per year provides protection during the whole season

Optimal results are obtained when attract and kill systems for the control of Spotted Wing Drosophila are applied to large fields with regular shape. In case the treated plot is adjacent to untreated plots or spontaneous vegetation, where Spotted Wing Drosophila can be present product may be applied to the borders per the label rates provided above.

The use of BioMagnetTM SWD should always take place in the context of an Integrated Pest Management strategy. The use of other pest control measures may be necessary and should be based on proper pest monitoring, field scouting and use of degree-day models.
