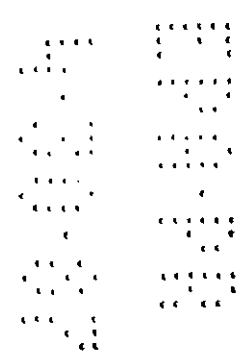

CAUTIONARY STATEMENTS  
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Avoid breathing of dust when you apply powder. Harmful if swallowed. Wash hands with soap and water after dusting animals. Do not use on kittens or puppies less than 4 weeks of age. Do not use on pregnant dogs or nursing animals. Keep out of reach of children.

Notice to Physician: Carbaryl is a cholinesterase inhibitor.  
Atropine is antidotal.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not apply directly to water.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching finger to back of throat. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Call a physician.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. If irritation persists, see a physician.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Give artificial respiration if indicated.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

How to Use: For best results to kill Fleas, Ticks, and Lice on Dogs, dust powder liberally over the entire body. Rub dust into hair and around the feet, pads and between the toes so that they are well treated. Begin at tail and work towards head. Take care not to get the powder in animal's eyes, nose or mouth. Dust bedding and kennel and sleeping area regularly. Repeat as needed, but not more often than once weekly.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in original container in cool, locked storage area.

Do not reuse bottle. Empty Completely, wrap in newspaper before discarding in trash.
