

For the control of sapstain and mold on green or freshly cut lumber, BRITEWOOD S, is generally effective when used as a 15 second dip at a concentration of 2 fluid ounces per gallon of water. For severe conditions of ambient temperature and humidity, BRITEWOOD S may be used at up to 4 fluid ounces per gallon of water in a dip tank or spray application so as to uniformly wet all surfaces of the wood. Green wood should be treated within twenty-four hours of cutting or sawing.
