Label submission dated April 14, 1968

The label you submitted to above, submitted in connection with your application for registration of Lindane, Insecticide, formulated as a wettable powder, for use on the following pests and plants, is hereby approved for registration under the amended label:

1. Add "Do not apply for agricultural use" directly under the word "Label" on the front panel.
2. Add "Aerial application of lindane is prohibited" directly under "It is a violation of Federal law...", rather than at the location "E" indicated on the submitted labeling. This statement is necessary because of the orchard use also.
3. Add "or wetlands" to "Do not apply directly to water" in the Environmental Hazards section.
4. Change the re-entry precaution to read:
Do not enter treated areas prior to 24 hours after application without protective clothing.

Please submit five (5) copies of the revised amended label prior to release for shipment under the amended labeling.
