FIRST AID

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Material crystallizes below 32°F. Do not heat above 176°F. Materials recommended for use with this product include stainless steel, polyethylene, polypropylene, PVC, CPVC, fiberglass made with reinforced resins such as polyesters and epoxides, and most rubbers. Fill the container 1/4 full with water. Replace and tighting closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into manufacturing equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Pressure rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into manufacturing equipment or a mix tank and continue to drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Hold container upside down over manufacturing equipment or mix tank or collect rinsate for later use or disposal. Insert pressurerinsing nozzle in the side of the container, and rinse at about 40 psi for at least 30 seconds. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Then offer for recycling if available, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures approved by State and local authorities.
