Do not open packages of the two insecticides until ready to use. Then, open packages and remove trap, cartridge and Insectape[®]. Remove protective film from Insectape[®] and insert along interior surface of cartridge, as illustrated. Remove protective wrap from cartridge and insert cartridge into the trap. Install trap on mooring line, being sure of a snug fit. To ensure efficacy, attach the device at the point on the mooring line closest to the boat. As illustrated, install with open end of trap nearest the dock. Replace cartridges, as needed. Install replacement cartridge in the same manner as the original cartridge.

Refer to diagram for details on installation.

Avoid contact of trap with water. **SHOULD TRAP FALL INTO THE WATER, RETRIEVE IMMEDIATELY.**

Do not place trap in exposed locations where direct contact with children, pets, food or clothing is likely to occur.

To alleviate existing cockroach infestations on the boat, use other EPA-registered products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store trap in original container and ensure that it is tightly closed. Store in a cool, dry place. Do not store with foods, drugs or personal contact items.

TRAP AND PACKAGING DISPOSAL: Securely wrap in several layers of paper and discard in trash.

DO NOT REUSE TRAP FOR PURPOSES OTHER THAN THOSE SPECIFIED ON THE LABEL.
