Dear Ms. Even:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following label revision provision(s):

Storage and Disposal Statement section comment(s), page 5 of 5:

1. Revise the existing "**Pesticide Storage:**" subsection to read "**Pesticide Storage:** Store AntGuard® for Hummingbird Feeders in its original container in a cool, dry place in an area that is inaccessible to children and animals. Do not store with food or feed."
2. Revise the existing "**Pesticide and Container Disposal:**" subsection to read "**Container Disposal:** Nonrefillable container. Do not refill or reuse empty container. Wrap used device in newspaper and discard in trash, or dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incinerate, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities. Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions."

A copy of your label stamped "Accepted with Comments" is enclosed for your records. Please submit two (2) copies of the final printed labeling, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with section 6(e) of FIFRA. To Install: First clean your hummingbird/nectar feeder and add fresh nectar according to manufacturer's instructions. Next, remove AntGuard® from package and extend the lower baffle (see illustration). Attach the AntGuard® below the hanging hook and above the hummingbird feeder (see photo on opposite panel of package). AntGuard® starts to work immediately; all ant activity should stop within 24 hours. Under normal conditions, AntGuard® will give a full season of ant control.

Repellent disk is inaccessible to feeding birds!

Feeder weight should not exceed 7 lbs.

[For Dispersment Stations]

To Install: First clean your station and add fresh insects, bait or food according to manufacturer's instructions.
