- Unwind pickup tube on the sprayer before attaching to the bottle.
- Insert pickup tube in bottle and screw sprayer cap onto bottle.



- Slide safety lock to the ON position. [Remove plastic tab to activate batteries]
- Gently squeeze the trigger to dispense fluid. The sprayer may require several seconds for the fluid to prime.
