On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

d. Delete "SPECIALLY FORMULATED FOR TANK SPRAYERS". No directions for use are given for tank sprayers.

e. For all indoor termite and wood damaging/destroying insect claims, the following statement must be added: "This type of application is not intended to be a substitute for soil treatment, mechanical alteration or fumigation to control extensive infestation of wood- infesting insects."

f. Under Environmental Hazards change "Do not contaminate...and requirements." to read "Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwater or rinsate."

g. Under Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals after "...using the toilet." add "All pesticide handlers (mixers, loaders, and applicators) must wear long-sleeved shirt and long pants, socks, shoes and chemical resistant gloves."

h. Under Storage and Disposal delete "Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling, if available."

i. Change "Storage" to "Pesticide Storage".

j. Replace the Disposal section with "Container Disposal: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. If empty: Offer for recycling, if available. 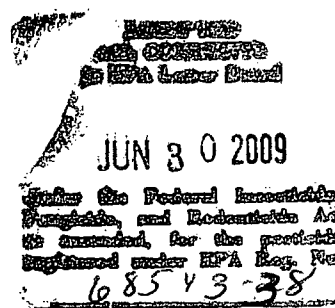

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
 Read Entire Label Before Using. Not for use in Federally Inspected Meat and Poultry Plants.



Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food and drinking water should be covered or removed before application.

Do not use in handheld fogging devices. Do not apply this product in a manner that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried. Do not treat pets with this product.

KILLS: Cockroaches, fleas, ticks, crickets, mosquitoes, flies, gnats, pillbugs, spiders (including black widow and brown recluse spiders), ants, fireants, centipedes, millipedes, small flying moths, Carpenter Ants, Carpenter Bees, Termites, earwigs, wasps, bees, yellow jackets, and hornets.

AMOUNT TO USE:

- Mix 2 fl. oz. of Insecticide Concentrate per gallon of water to make a 0.06% Bifenthrin dilution for maximum residual control [up to 16 weeks] [up to 4 months]
- Mix 1 fl. oz. of Insecticide Concentrate per gallon of water to make a 0.03% Bifenthrin dilution for maintenance purposes.
- Mix ½ fl. oz. of Insecticide Concentrate per gallon of water to make a 0.015% Bifenthrin dilution for light infestations of cockroaches or ants.

1 fl oz. = 2 tablespoons = 6 teaspoons. Do not use measuring spoons for food purposes after use with pesticides.
