3. Delete the statement, "Kills aphids in 2 to 4 days" or change it to, "Kills some aphid species on some plants as early as three days after application."

4. Delete the claim of fast acting from the front panel and from the statement: "Celaflor Rose Patch is a fast acting method to control aphids and other insects on roses and ornamental plants" on second page under the homeowner use heading. Submitted efficacy data do not substantiate the fast acting claim.

5. Add a statement that the patches may not provide adequate control against the green peach aphid for the first two weeks after application.

6. Change the statement "Protects for 8 weeks" to "May provide protection against some aphid species for up to 8 weeks," on the front panel and on second page under the homeowner use heading.

7. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. A copy of the efficacy review is also enclosed for your perusal.

**For Use on Roses, Azaleas, Hibiscus, Schefflera, Viburnum, Fatsia and Ficus.**

**CELAFLO**R Rose Patch is a fast acting method to control aphids and other insects on roses and ornamental plants. Using the same technology as nicotine and medicine patches, **CELAFLO**R Rose Patch continuously releases insecticide through the bark to all upper stems and plant parts. As insects suck out or feed on the plant's juices, they ingest the insecticide and die quickly. Aphids are controlled within 2 to 4 days and the protection lasts for 8 weeks. Controls mites, thrips, white flies, planthoppers, leaf miners and scale insects when used early at first appearance.

**Not for use on or around fruit trees or vegetable plants.**

**Directions For Use**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Read all directions carefully before use.

This package contains 5 envelopes, each containing 4 patches. Remove a green patch from the foil by holding only at the end of the patch, where there is no glue. Wrap one patch around the base of each main branch. For roses, choose locations without thorns or remove thorns that may be in the way. For stem roses, one patch at the upper part of the stem is sufficient. Press firmly to ensure that the patch sticks to the branch or stem. Remove and discard the patch when effectiveness has diminished (after 8 weeks).

**Storage and Disposal**

**Storage:** Store only in original container in a cool, dry place out of the reach of children and pets.

**Disposal:** Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
