The following amendment submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is accepted with conditions.

- Change primary brand name
- Add new company name and address
- Update First Aid Statement
- Revise directions to include the Medical Waste Processor models manufactured by Technology 2100.

Conditions

Revise the Ingredient Statement as follows:

2. The instructions "Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment" must be added above the Note to Physician.

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- 3. Revise the "If In Eyes" statement under the First Aid section as follows:
 - Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.
 - Remove contact lenses, if present after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing the eye.*
 - Call poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

*Note: The statement "Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor" was removed from this section and replace by the contact lense instructions.
