#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For Controlling Odor-Causing Microorganisms in Residential and Industrial Ion Exchange Resin Beds During Regeneration

#### Use Instructions:.

- Close inlet and outlet water valves to prefilter housing or tablet doser housing.
- Remove bowl from either the prefilter housing or the tablet doser housing.
- 3. Empty water from bowl.
- 4. For each cubic foot of Ion Exchange Resin, add 30 grams (1.06 oz.) of Aseptrol S2-Tab to the bowl.
- 5. Replace bowl on housing and open water valves.
- 6. Proceed with normal regeneration cycle.

Or

- 1. Remove the cover from the brine tank.
- For each cubic foot of lon Exchange Resin, add 30 grams (1.06 oz.) of Aseptrol S2-Tab to the brine well of the brine tank
- Do not place Aseptrol S2-Tab onto dry salt MUST BE PLACED IN LIQUID ONLY.
- Cover brine tank and proceed with normal regeneration cycle.

For Use Against Canine Parvovirus, Mouse Hepatitis Virus (MHV), Sialodacryoadenitis virus (SDAV), Murine Parainfluenza virus type 1 (Sendai), Mouse Parvovirus type 1 (MPV-1), and Minute virus of Mice (MVM) in Animal Rearing and Confinement Facilities Such as Kennels and Cages

#### **Use Instructions:**

- Remove all animals and feed from premises, vehicles, enclosures, coops and crates.
- Remove all litter and manure from floors, walls and surfaces of pens, stalls, chutes and other facilities and fixtures occupied or traversed by animals.
- Empty all troughs, racks and other feeding and watering appliances.
- Thoroughly clean all surfaces with soap and detergent and rinse with water.
- Place a 10 gram (0.353 oz.) Aseptrol S2-Tab tablet into a clean, plastic pail and add one-half (0.5) gallon of clean potable water. Prepare in a well-ventilated area. Allow the tablet to completely dissolve. This will yield a working solution containing about 100 ppm of free chlorine dioxide.
- 6. To Apply: Using commercial sprayer, saturate all surfaces with the use-solution until all areas are wet. Allow to penetrate surface and to remain wet for 10 minutes. Immerse all collars, ropes and other types of equipment used in handling and restraining animals as well as forks, shovels and scrapers used for removing litter.

- 8. Thoroughly scrub treated feed racks, troughs, automatic feeders, fountains and waterers with soap or detergent and rinse with potable water before use.
