
- 4. Replace "repels moths" to "kills moths", wherever it occurs.
- 5. Your Ingredient Statement is not readable and is not distinct from other text, which is unacceptable [40 CFR 156(a)]. Place the Ingredient Statement in a separate location on the Front Panel, preferably in a box, with a minimum type size of 6 pt and with text contrasting clearly against the background (e.g., green on white). To make the text more readable, increase the space between the letters.
- 6. The minimum type size requirement for the "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" heading is the same as "KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN". Therefore, for the "ball" product, you need to increase the type size from 6 to 10 Pt. See Attachment 3, "Minimum Type Size Requirements for Final Printed Labels" for additional details. Other labels will also have to be modified.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

TO KILL CLOTHES MOTHS

Use Restrictions: For control of eggs, larvae, and adults of clothes moths in clean, air-tight containers (e.g., chests and trunks) and garment bags. Do not use in containers, dry cleaning, and garbage bags that allow vapors to escape into occupied rooms. Do not use this naphthalene-containing product with any other moth control chemical. As this product can damage some plastics, use only in polyethylene or polypropylene containers.

Pre-Application Directions: Before storing, dry clean, wash or brush articles to be protected.

Application Directions: Apply product only in clean, air-tight containers and bags listed above at the following rates:
