Dear Jennifer Fulford:

The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. This approval does not affect any conditions that were previously imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance.

Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance

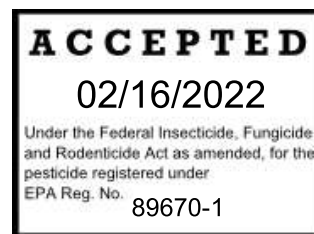

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMAN AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION. Harmful if swallowed. Causes moderate eye irritation. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling bait or bait station and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Wear: long pants, socks, shoes, and waterproof gloves when handling bait or dead rodents.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to birds and other wildlife. Do not apply this product directly to water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Use only to control house mice inside homes and buildings.

READ THIS LABEL: Read this entire label and follow all use directions and use restrictions. Use only for the sites, pest and application methods described on this label.

USE RESTRICTIONS: This bait station may be used in indoor areas accessible to children and pets, consistent with all use restrictions and other requirements indicated in this label. **DO NOT USE THIS PRODUCT OUTDOORS.**

Do not place this bait station in any area where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come into direct contact with food. Do not place near or inside ventilation duct openings.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS: Determine areas where house mice will most likely find and consume bait. Generally, these areas are along walls, by gnawed openings, in corners and concealed places, between floors or walls, or in locations where house mice and their signs have been seen. Remove as much alternative food and harborage (e.g., clutter piles, unused boxes, etc.) as possible.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

Opening, Refilling and Reclosing the Mouse Bait Stations:

1) To open the Bait Station, put on gloves and insert the plastic key into the lock on top of the Bait Station lid. Push the key all the way down into the lock and turn the key in the direction of the arrow to open the station lid.

2) REMOVE AND SAVE KEY

3) Remove the plastic bait holder and discard any remaining bait from both the holder and the bait station. Place two 5g refill Black Pearl Paste sachets into each side of the plastic bait holder, with center holes facing upward (each station should always contain four 5g sachets).

4) Insert plastic bait holder with the four 5g refill sachets into the **MIDDLE COMPARTMENT** of the Bait Station.

5) **WITH KEY STILL REMOVED** and plastic bait holder and refills in place, snap the lid of the Bait Station shut by pressing down on the lock.

6) CLEAN AROUND THE BAIT STATION AREA BY REMOVING ALL REMAINING BAIT AND BAIT CRUMBS. ENSURE THAT GLOVES AND BAIT ARE DISPOSED OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN, PETS AND WILDLIFE.

7) Wash hands thoroughly.

Placement of Bait Stations That Have Been Filled:

1) Place filled bait station in horizontal position with side against walls or other vertical surfaces, exposing the entrance holes. (See **Use Restrictions** and **Selection of Treatment Areas**.)

2) After determining treatment area(s), if more than one bait station is used, place the bait station(s) every 8 to 12 feet (2.5 to 3.5 meters) along walls and corners where house mice or their signs have been seen. Place a single bait station at each location.

3) Regularly check bait stations (s) for consumption. If no feeding occurs after three days, move stations to areas where house mouse activity is evident. If bait has been removed or has become soiled or spoiled, remove residual material and reload the station with four new Black Pearl Paste sachets. Replace bait as necessary to maintain a constant supply of fresh bait for 21 days or until signs of house mouse activity cease.

4) Using waterproof gloves, collect and dispose of all visible dead animals and leftover bait properly.

5) To discourage re-infestation, limit sources of rodent food, water and harborage as much as possible. If re-infestation occurs, repeat treatment.
