





DESIGNATIONS IN US EPA REGION 9 FOR THE 1971 CARBON MONOXIDE (CO) NATIONAL AMBIENT AIR QUALITY STANDARDS (NAAQS)

-  Attainment (Maintenance area)
-  Unclassifiable/Attainment
-  County boundary
-  State boundary or coastline

The 1971 primary NAAQS for CO with an 8-hour averaging time is 9 parts per million (ppm), not to be exceeded more than once a year. The NAAQS for CO with a 1-hour averaging time is 35 ppm, not to be exceeded more than once per year. Currently there are no areas in Region 9 that violate the CO NAAQS. Other US territories in the Pacific have been designated "Unclassifiable/Attainment".
