






DESIGNATIONS IN US EPA REGION 9 FOR THE 2010 1-HOUR SULFUR DIOXIDE (SO₂) NATIONAL AMBIENT AIR QUALITY STANDARDS (NAAQS)

-  Attainment/Unclassifiable
-  State boundary

The primary national ambient air quality standard (NAAQS) for 1-hour sulfur dioxide (SO₂) is 75 parts per billion (ppb). Areas that have SO₂ pollution levels above the NAAQS have been designated "Nonattainment". Other US territories in the Pacific have been designated "Attainment/Unclassifiable".
