The Hawaii Department of Health, in partnership with the Hawaii County Civil Defense Agency and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, has expanded air quality monitoring in the lower east rift zone during the Kilauea volcanic eruption on Hawaii Island. The new monitors are providing real-time information on air quality and possible health impacts, using the Hawaii County's three-color public notification system.
