Dear Mr. Garvin:

In accordance with the requirements of Section 107(d)(1) of the Clean Air Act, Maryland's boundary recommendations under the 2012 annual fine particle (PM2.5) standard are provided below in Table 1.

Maryland recommends that EPA designate all of Maryland as attainment with respect to the 2012 annual PM2.5 standard. Based upon the 2012 PM2.5 design values from Maryland's air quality monitoring network, no counties in Maryland violate the 2012 annual primary and secondary PM2.5 standards. In making this recommendation, Maryland has utilized EPA's "April 2013 Guidance for Area Designations for the 2012 Annual PM2.5 NAAQS" and reviewed the Five-Factor Analysis which includes: Air Quality Data, Emissions and Emissions-Related Data, Meteorology, Geography/Topography, and Jurisdictional Boundaries.

Maryland is pleased to submit this recommendation, as it represents the first designation recommendation for either the PM2.5 or Ozone standards in which all of Maryland is in attainment at the time of designation.

Table 1 summarizes the specific areas that Maryland is recommending be designated as in attainment.
